Salida was recently awarded a GOCO Grant of \$240,000, with contributions of \$15,000 from Chaffee County and \$10,000 from Peak to Peak Pickleball Club and Salida Tennis Club, to build new tennis/pickleball courts on the east side of the Aquatic Center. The new facilities will include two tennis courts, with eight pickleball courts, fencing, lights, windscreens, restrooms, drinking fountains and a paved parking lot. The new courts are expected to be completed and open by Fall 2018.
